Federal Direct Parent (PLUS) Loans are available from the U.S. Department of Education to help parents of dependent students pay the cost of their child's education. To borrow a PLUS loan, you must be the biological or adoptive parent (or, in some cases, the stepparent) of the student for whom you are borrowing.

West Coast University will certify a parent PLUS loan for the aid year and amounts listed below after we receive notification by the Department of Education that the parent borrower has successfully passed a credit check and completed a valid Master Promissory Note. Parents must first obtain a verified FSA ID to access the website, and in some instances may be required to also complete electronic PLUS counseling. The student must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year that a PLUS loan is requested.
