Working in conjunction with the Department of Veteran Affairs, West Coast University is participating in the Yellow Ribbon program. The Yellow Ribbon program provides additional benefits to fund tuition and fee expenses that exceed the tuition and fee amounts payable under the Post-9/11 GI Bill®. Eligible students* (California only) will be selected and approved to receive Yellow Ribbon funding, on a first come-first served basis. The Yellow Ribbon Program payment is remitted directly to the University on behalf of the student when the University's enrollment certification is processed.

(*100 students in Ontario, 80 students in Anaheim, 60 students in Los Angeles)

Eligibility Requirements – Student Must:

- ▶ Have served an aggregate period of active duty after September 10, 2001, of at least 36 months
- ▶ Be honorably discharged from active duty for a service connected disability and served 30 continuous days after September 10, 2001
- ▶ Be a dependent eligible for Transfer of Entitlement under the Post-9/11 GI Bill® based on a veteran's service under the eligibility criteria listed above
- ▶ Be eligible for the maximum benefit rate under the Post-9/11 GI Bill®
- ▶ Not be on active duty

All official transcripts detailing prior higher education credits must be submitted to the Registrar's office in order to be certified for Veterans benefits.
