Speech-language pathologists treat and prevent communication and swallowing disorders in children and adults. It's a rewarding healthcare field where you can work with patients to improve their quality of life.


West Coast University's Master of Speech-Language Pathology (MSLP) program helps prepare students to pursue autonomous practice in the field. Aiming to give you flexibility and individualized support, the program allows you to complete coursework online while taking part in hands-on learning experiences. Students will complete virtual skills labs, on-site intensives, and clinical hours to help them gain mastery in the speech-language pathology field.

On program completion, students will be eligible to sit for the PRAXIS II certification exam.
